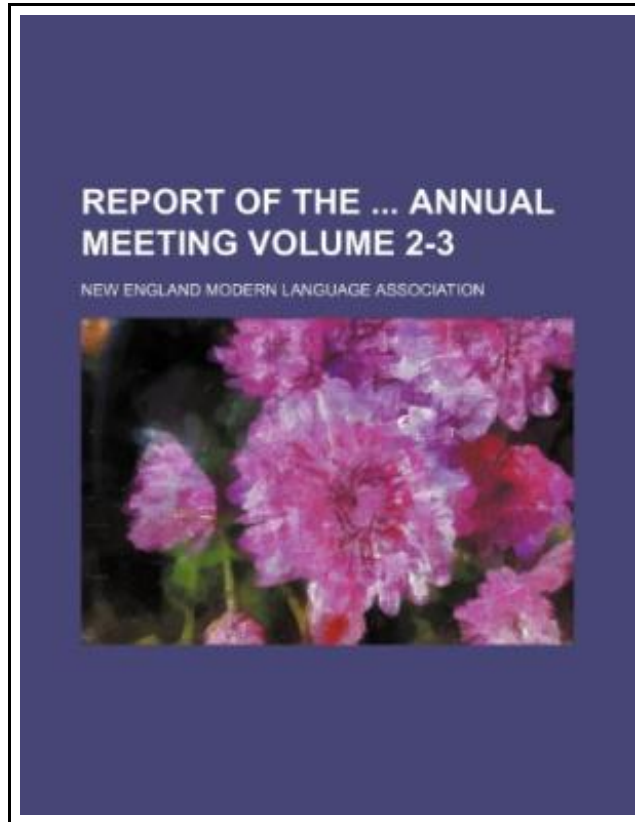

Not illustrated. 1905 Excerpt: . . . it was felt that a still larger number might be induced to take part in the work of the Association if it were not necessary to travel quite so far in order to do so. Accordingly a meeting of the Modern Language teachers of Worcester County was held in the Worcester City Hall on Nov. 27, 1905, to discuss the advisability of forming another group. The meeting was addressed by Professor Fay, the President of the Association, who gave the movement his hearty encouragement. At the close of his address the meeting voted to petition the Directors of the Association to be admitted as the Worcester Group and elected the following list of officers: Chairman, S. P. Capen, Clark University; Vice-Chairman, G. F. Cole, Worcester South High School; Secretary, Eleanor Conlon, Worcester South High School; Librarian, F. A. Wilson, Worcester Classical High School; Programme Committee, F. D. Aldrich, Worcester Academy; S. T. Chase, Worcester Polytechnic Institute, and S. P. Capen. Since its establishment the group has held two regular meetings, one January 10, and the other March 28, both at Clark University. It has been the aim of the Programme Committee to encourage free informal discussion; if possible to get every one to say something. This end could better be served, it was believed, by proposing some general question upon which all were invited to express their views, than by the presentation of set papers on special topics.
