Schiller's greatest work is probably his Wilhelm Tell, though it is thought by some that this drama is equalled by his Wallenstein. Marie Stuart was written after the latter and before the former of these two plays, about four or five years prior to the author's death. From a technical standpoint, the Marie Stuart is entitled to rank as one of the best of the poet's compositions, but there is a spirit about the...
